We are ready to see you for our fall events and next years summer camp!

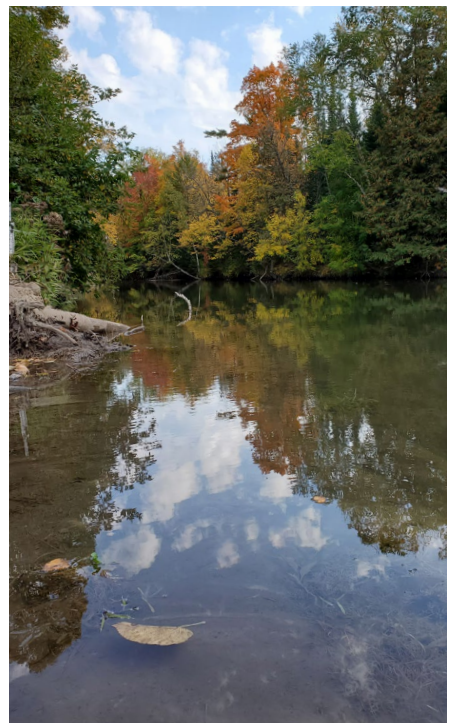
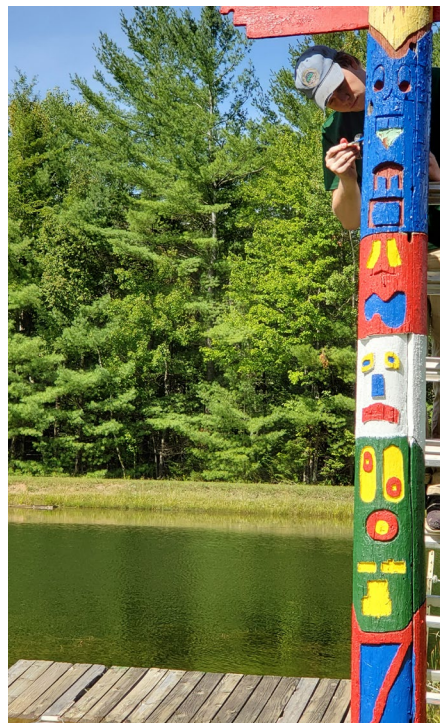
Haunted Campsite

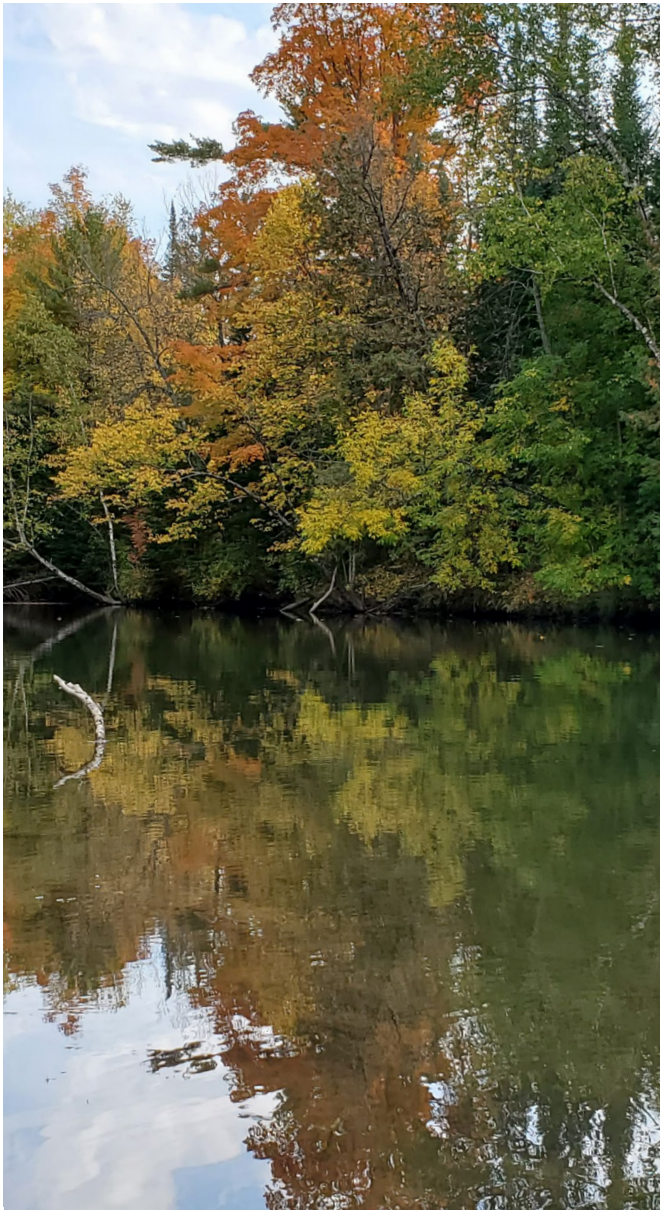

Our annual Fall Clean Up weekend is approaching! We will be holding the clean up process from November 6th-8th.

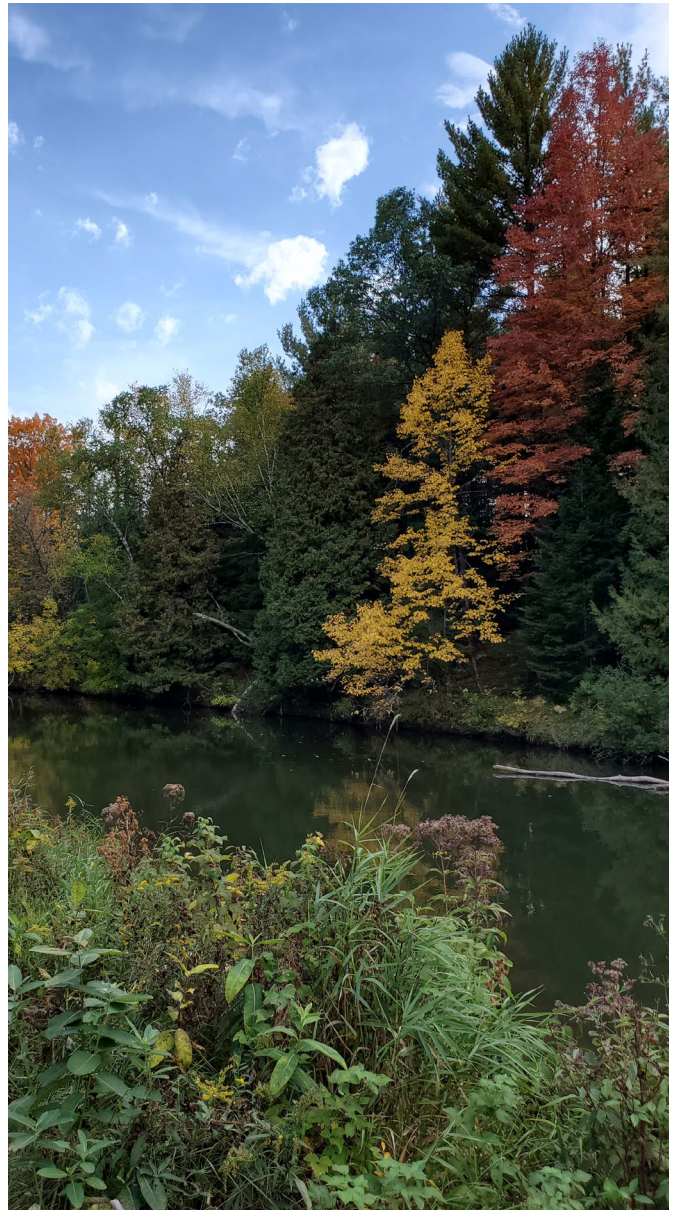

New Event

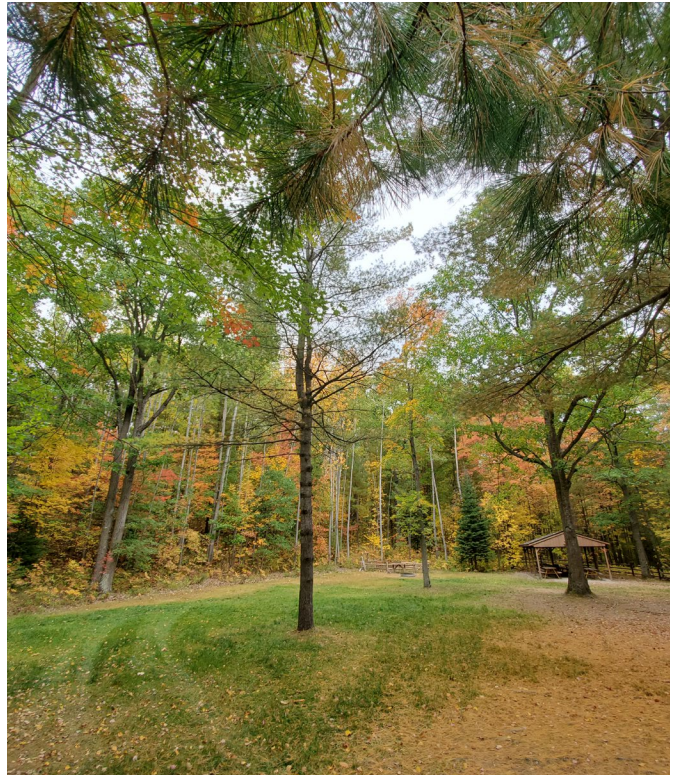

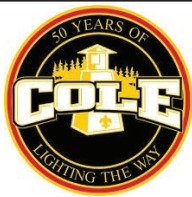
