

## SUMMER CAMP MERIT BADGE SELECTION WORKSHEET

Most of our MCC Camps utilize block-scheduling to best administer their Merit Badge Program & additional activities. Most classes and activities have a set capacity which can be determined by any of the following factors:

1. NCAP Standards (which state a class capacity based on safety and/or staffing requirements)

2. Equipment Availability (i.e. If there are only 15 canoes then only 28 people can take the class [2 per canoe + 1 instructor canoe])

3. Time to Complete (i.e. Every person in welding must make 5 welds at approx. 10 minutes per person; class is only 60 minutes long)

Merit Badge sign-up is completed on a first-come, first-served basis. To assist your Scouts in selecting merit badge classes, please utilize the table below. This will give you each Scouts' preferred class AND a back-up class so that you can make the appropriate merit badge selections based on availability at time of selection. Please refer to the Summer Camp Leader's Guide for Merit Badge selection date and time – as well as all other pertinent information relating to the Merit Badge Program.
